Don't miss the revelation that is right in front of you.

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows.

When I was in 8th grade I rocked a super cool 10-speed. You remember the ones with the curved handlebars that looked like ram's horns? I recall an incident when I was showing off on my new bike in front of a group of girls, but while my eyes were looking at them, I missed what was right in front of me, the back of a parked car. Needless to say, the car and I had an appointment that day because my eyes were looking everywhere except where they should have been.

Sometimes I feel like God's revelation is like this. It's not that God isn't revealing, it's that we are missing it because we are so distracted. Other things have turned our attention away from the circumstances or situations that God is calling us through. And that revelation doesn't always come in earth shattering, mind blowing ways. It's often in the simple and seemingly insignificant. Sometimes it's so subtle that if you aren't paying careful attention, you will miss it completely. Give God your full attention. Look for Him in those things that are right in front of you and avail yourself to His call on your life.

As a Home Group, take a moment and consider individually what God has been desiring to speak to you. In prayer, acknowledge your willingness to hear and obey God.




reflect (25 min)

As you've had the opportunity to reflect on what God has spoken to you through the lesson this week, consider these questions as a group and discuss them together.

1. Has God been seeking to get your attention on an issue or situation in your life? What is that issue? **Describe how He has been seeking to get your attention and how you are going to going to intentionally avail yourself to God.**

God gives revelation with the expectation that we will look, listen, align and avail ourselves to Him and His will.





BIBLICAL KEY

When you study the Bible you are studying God's word. As B.B. Warfield said, "The Bible is the Word of God in such a way that when the Bible speaks, God speaks."

2. The ground that Moses was standing on was holy because of God's presence. God told Moses to take off His sandals, an action that not only acknowledged God's holiness but aligned Moses to God and His ways. When we come to God, we have to come His way.

In your walk with God what areas need to be aligned to Him and His ways? Make a list and describe the changes that you will make.

God takes what is ordinary and makes it sacred by His presence not our works.

3. God is the Great Rescuer of souls. He personally disclosed to Moses how much He cared for the children of Israel and invited Moses to be a part of His divine plan to deliverer them. God invites you to be a part of His Divine Rescue. **What steps can you take to have a greater impact for the gospel through your life. What things are holding you back, that you need to give to God?**

"For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it." Mark 8:35

"I like to burn churches rather than houses, because they do not burn down, they burn up, and keep on burning when the fire is of the right sort. When a bush is nothing but a bush, it is soon consumed when it is set on fire; but when it is a bush that burns on and is not consumed, we may know that *God is there*. So is it with a church that is flaming with holy zeal. Your work, brethren, is to set your church on fire. You may do it by speaking to the whole of the members, or you may do it by speaking to the few choice spirits, but you must do it somehow. Have a secret society for this sacred purpose, turn yourselves into a band of celestial Fenians whose aim it is to set the whole church on fire."
