



Hybrid Home Group Guidelines

Hybrid Home Groups have been given the green light to begin as part of Calvary Chapel Las Vegas' phasing process moving toward in-person gatherings.

Here is the official communication that went out to the church:

"We are excited to announce, after much prayer and consideration, that Home Groups will be the first ministry that will resume in-person gatherings. These new guidelines were made with everyone's health and safety in mind, especially those of you who are elderly, have underlying health issues, or compromised immune systems.

Hybrid Home Groups, will give home group leaders and attendees the option to meet in person and online. In person meetings should not exceed 10 people. And anyone who isn't able or feel comfortable can continue to use a virtual platform.

If you have questions about a current Home Group, please reach out to the leader, they will be able to direct you further. Our newly added Online Home Groups will continue to meet as-is for now and they are still open to anyone to join."

Home Group Leaders now have the option to begin moving in this direction beginning May 25. It will ultimately be the leader who will make their own decision for their group.

This is how we have implemented the state approved guidelines as communicated by Governor Sisolak:

1. Hybrid Home Groups should not exceed more than 10 people in-person, including children. If there are more than 10, the online option will be used to accommodate larger groups.
2. We are asking Home Group Leaders to provide an online option when a Home Group exceeds 10 people *and for those in your group who are in the vulnerable population*
3. If Home Group Leaders are not ready to open up their homes, then they may continue with the online only model
4. When meeting in person, please respect each other's space by practicing social distancing to the best of your ability with those that don't reside in your household

We care about everyone's health and safety and want especially those who are "vulnerable individuals" to refrain from attending Home Groups in person in accordance with the governor's caution.

Use of face coverings or PPE's is at the discretion of each individual who participates in Home Groups. Home Group leaders will be given the room to guide their groups in this area.



Each Home Group already has its own policy for children. As it relates to this new guideline, children of all ages are welcome in Hybrid Home Groups as long as social distancing is being practiced and the count does not exceed 10 people.

Home Group Leaders will take the necessary steps to ensure a safe, clean, and healthy environment for the attendees.

We will adjust and will remain fluid to ensure we align with government guidelines as they change.

We thank you for your patience as we navigate through these unprecedented times together.
