### What is your cleaning protocol?

Facilities department has established an enhanced cleaning and disinfecting routine to ensure disinfection protocols follow product instructions for application and contact time. All contact surfaces will be disinfected on a stringent schedule, including restrooms, common areas, and office spaces. Appropriate disinfectants meeting EPA's criteria for use against SARS-CoV-2 are being used. All rooms used for services and LV Kids classrooms will all follow the same stringent protocols for sanitation.

### Is everyone required to wear face-coverings?

Face-coverings are encouraged but not required. Please follow your conscience in this matter.

### How will seating be handled?

Seating is open allowing everyone to choose the seat that suits them as they are available. If you desire a socially-distanced seat we recommend sitting on the far left or right of the stage in the Gym. There is additional seating in the Multipurpose Room (MPR).

### Will there be maximum capacity for services?

We're not turning anyone away.

### What precautions are you taking for at-risk congregants?

All congregants whose health is compromised in any way or who fall into the vulnerable population are highly urged to continue to watch services (at [live.cclasvegas.org](http://live.cclasvegas.org)) and participate with ministries online (at [cclasvegas.org/connect](http://cclasvegas.org/connect).)

### What if someone in my family is sick?

We ask that if you or a family member have been exposed to someone who is ill or test positive for COVID-19 or displayed ANY signs of sickness over the past 2 weeks that you stay home until you are well in order to protect everyone within the church from infection. Please keep children home who are displaying any signs of illness.

### How can I tithe in person?

Offering bags will not be passed during service. There will be a time of giving during service and everyone will be encouraged to give online (at [cclasvegas.org/give](http://cclasvegas.org/give)), or through text (702.710.4784 with the amount) or using our app. Tithe boxes will be available for dropping off envelopes before or after service.

### Will everyone be required to have their temperature taken?

No. CCLV staff and volunteers reporting to duty are required to have their temperature taken. On-going ministries meeting on campus will also require temperatures being taken if meetings take place on campus. If you have a fever, cold symptoms, compromised immune systems, or fall into the vulnerable population you are encouraged to participate online only.
