### Episode 1 | Hebrews 12:1-2



True Bible faith is confident obedience to God's Word in spite of circumstances and consequences

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows. How important is faith to the believer? You might think that's an odd question to ask because the answer seems so obvious, right? But truth be told, we need to be reminded even as Christians of how paramount faith, real living faith is. The Bible never presents faith as a one-time event. Neither does it reduce Christianity to a set of repetitive behaviors. Faith means relationship, and relationship is rooted in God's love. God's love is received through the cross of Christ, which is the starting point of our faith. Faith in this regard is so critical to the Christian that the author of the book of Hebrews said, "Without faith it is impossible to please God." In fact, the recipients of that epistle needed such a strong encouragement because they were drifting from their faith. They were under attack for being Christians, struggling with their own doubts and beginning to wander away from Jesus.

There is a healthy way to deal with doubt so that you are strengthened in your faith and not weakened.

As a Home Group, take a moment and share what you desire to see God do the most this summer. Spend time in prayer asking God to deepen our faith in God.

So, in an effort to be honest, what are examples in our lives where our decisions tore us down spiritually instead of building us up? Share how God turned those decisions around in your life.

Lay aside concerning your former conduct, the old nature which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind.

3. Share examples of how we sometimes can put up lenses that obscure Jesus to others. How can we safeguard ourselves from complicating faith and Jesus?

And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.
