Week 7 | Identify The Problem | Genesis 3

WHEN YOU PLAY WITH SIN YOU GET BURNED

The story is told of a woman who played the lottery weekly, meticulously following the same pattern. She would buy the ticket, write down the numbers in her notebook and then give the ticket to her husband to hold on to. One day as the EuroMillions winning numbers were posted, she hurried to her notebook to read the numbers only to find that she had won! However, when she went to retrieve the winning ticket from her husband, she was crushed to discover that he had thrown the ticket away, probably because he was so used to losing. The loss was a stunning \$181 million! Who can fathom making such a horrible decision that would cost so much? Well, the answer is Adam and Eve. In fact, their failure has cost much more over thousands of years of human history. Thank God that He can redeem our failures. And as we carefully study Genesis 3, we will discover that the failures of Adam and Eve provide some of the strongest lessons on how to transform our relationships.

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows.



PRAY (10 min)

As a Home Group, take time to consider how God has rescued you from bad decisions. Spend time in prayer thanking God for His forgiveness and grace.

REFLECT (25 min)

As you've had the opportunity to reflect on what God has spoken to you through the lesson this week, consider these questions as a group and discuss them.

Pastor Derek mentioned three enemies that make having healthy relationships very difficult. What are those enemies? Describe why they make healthy relationships hard (i.e., why you can't follow the culture's ques on relationships).

Why do you think the serpent attacked God's word when he was tempting Eve? Why is God's word 2. important when it comes to our relationships? Provide some Scripture references to support.

3. Adam and Eve should have run to God, not from God.

Are there issues in your life that you need to bring to God? Are there relationships that you need to trust Him with or that you need His help to handle? Create a prayer list and begin to pray regularly and earnestly for God to help you with these things.

Your greatest failures can become God's greatest miracles and your greatest lessons.

4. It appears from Scripture that Adam was present when Eve was being deceived. If so, he failed to lead his wife towards God.

With that in mind, would your friends and family say that you influence them to love God and grow spiritually? How can you be a better spiritual influence?

Healthy relationships lead people to God not away from God. To obey God, not to sin against Him.

5. When Eve's conversation started going in the wrong direction with the serpent, she should have immediately cut it off.

Are there compromises or sins in your life that need to be cut off?

Remember that the devil is behind every temptation. When you play with sin you will get burned.

REACH (5 min)
