THE CHRISTIAN LIFE ISN'T A PLAYGROUND IT'S A BATTLEGROUND

A few years ago, there was a conference held at the United Nations. To welcome delegates from the many countries, they stretched a banner across the front of the UN building that said "Welcome" in different languages. But there was a tiny mistake in one language. The translators mistyped one letter, so instead of saying, "Welcome," it said "Circumcision." Undoubtedly, the people who spoke that language were hesitant to enter, considering the pain that was to follow!

I believe that in our messaging of the gospel, we sometimes over-focus on the benefits of the invitation at the expense of relating the cost. By that I mean, that while the Christian life is amazing, as we are welcomed into the family of God, it simultaneously means that we are entering into a life of real spiritual warfare. Unfortunately, many Christians attempt to live their lives without regard to this spiritual reality and pay a price for it daily, while God has given us all the tools we need to be victorious.

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows.



PRAY (10 min)

As a Life Group, take time to consider the times when God has given you the victory in a spiritual battle. Be specific about what He did.



REFLECT (25 min)

As you've had the opportunity to reflect on what God has spoken to you through the lesson this week, consider these questions as a group and discuss them.

Do you believe that the conflict that exists in the spiritual realm manifests itself in the physical realm? If you do, what are some of the implications of this reality for the Christian? What has it looked like in your life? Why is it an important consideration for the person sincerely seeking to follow Jesus?

4. Pastor Derek mentioned seven tools that you can use daily to be victorious in the spiritual battle. Which tools stood out to you and why? How do you plan on practically implementing these tools in your life?
