START HERE #23: GENESIS 22:1-19 LAY IT ON THE ALTAR

ABRAHAM LOVED GOD WORSHIPED HIM - Not Casual Worshiper (like so mny xians): altars, righteousness, prayed, believed God, **GAVE POSSESS**

- The biggest test yet to come - ONE THAT HE NEVER COULD HAVE IMAG

God: Take your only son whom you love more than anything. The fulfillment of the promise that I have given to you and the hope of the promise to be fulfilled. Slay him and burn his body as a sacrifice to me, to ensure that you love me more than your son, more than the promises that I have given to you, more than anything.

- Our isaacs can become our idols – our blessings can become abominations MP: To be worshipers of God we must be willing to put on the altar what we love to ensure that we love Him the most.

The point is that our love for God is greater than all other things. **Hierarchy of loves** Luke 14:26 "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate (love less) his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.

Salvation is a gift but truly following Christ will cost you everything.

ABRAHAM TESTED - WHY WOULD GOD DO THIS?

Common practice heathen nations sacrificing children - GOD KNEW STEP IN...

- Why in sense of objection (how) > privilege What is man that ur mindful
 - Way of God with His children

The purpose of testing isn't p/f it's the process of growing through refining. Perfecting. Tests don't reveal to God what He doesn't see, they reveal to us what we don't see.

Areas devoted, sins repented, idols abandoned, faith strengthened – NEVER STOPS 1 Peter 1:7 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

TRAJECTORY OF ABRAHAM'S VICTORY

PREPARED: prepared for this moment because of prior obedience **RESPONDS RIGHT:** – **Call** - **Response** – **Command** – **Obedience/Faith/Worship**

- PROMPT OBEDIENCE: Hardly prompt When God calls us to do the hard things Denial (wasn't God, that's not for me), anger (how could HE!!) bargaining (maybe He will accept something else), depression (what will my life be w/0 this), Our faith is not really tested until God asks us to bear what seems unbearable, do what seems unreasonable, and expect what seems impossible.
 - STRUGGLED CHOSE OB. FAITH CONCL. judgment/decision settles a matter
 - o GOD WILL DO IT HE PROMISED / HE WILL PROVIDE "say it"

Hebrews 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*, ¹⁸ of whom it was said, "*In Isaac your seed shall be called*," ¹⁹ **concluding** that God *was* able to raise *him* up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.

- Make the faith conclusion and stop the spinning TURNS IT INTO WORSH
 WORSHIPS: Because of the determination He made in His heart:
- If we are obedient on the outside but miserable faithless inside - **WORSHIP?** Obedience is better than disobedience, but worship is the best of all, because worship is not only action it is also attitude.

Because HE CHOSE TO TRUST GOD, HIS PROMISE AND HIS POWER. Because He was unwilling to hold anything back from God this act of obedience and faith became worship.

- God may not call uTHIS - IF YOU'RE HIS HE'S CALLING YOU TO LAY DOWN SOMETHING.... EASY LAY DOWN YOUR LIFE - don't squabble anymore

If He doesn't have everything it won't be easy for you to lay down anything. Romans 12:1-2 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ESV
