

Life With One Another

Hebrews 10:24-25

Following Jesus is a way of life, and that life is meant to be lived in community with one another. Jesus intended His disciples to live together for a purpose. Still, often it is easy for us as Christians to think that we do not need community with other believers. Yet we are called to do life together because when we live life together, we are transformed into the image of Jesus. The community of God allows us to stand together for the sake of the Gospel and live out the ultimate vision of Jesus for His people.

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows.



PRAY (10 min)

As a Life Group, take time in prayer to ask the Lord to give you love for each other and bless your community.



REFLECT (25 min)

As you've had the opportunity to reflect on what God has spoken to you through the lesson this week, consider these questions as a group and discuss them.

1. Community begins with vulnerability.

Find someone within your Life Group to share your testimony with. Remember, our testimony is not about the evil we have done but about what Jesus has done in us. Make sure to give the other person time to talk as well.
